
Course Organization Strategies

Structure lessons as sequential steps, each building on the previous, to develop skills or knowledge systematically.




Narrative Flow (Storyline)

Arrange lessons to follow a storyline, creating an engaging and memorable learning journey.




Modular Design

Structure lessons so that each one introduces a foundational concept or skill, with subsequent lessons adding complexity or depth.




Chronological Ordering
